### **Environmentally Preferable Products and Services**

*In our construction work, we encourage the re-use of material and the use of green sustainable products. We also perform lifecycle analysis to demonstrate the value of these products. In our own office, we encourage the use of natural and reusable products. No plastic cups, Styrofoam or plastic grocery bags are used.*

### **Environmental Restoration or Community Environmental Projects**

*The owner is the President of the Professional Women in Construction-DC Chapter and every year ensures that the group has an event to discuss, educate and update members on green sustainable practices. We also participate in programs where we can help restore buildings. For example, in January, we dedicated half a day in honor of Martin Luther King Day by donating low VOC paint and helping to repaint and upgrade Ballou High School in DC.*

We re-use fax paper for note taking and use rechargeable batteries instead of disposable. We also use cups or reusable water bottles and reusable bags and donate business suits*

- *All light bulbs have been replaced to energy efficient bulbs*
