When our parts are complete and ready to return to customer, we use recycled paper for packing instead of Styrofoam.

We reuse oil in some of our processes.

Recycling

We send re-used oil to a public oil recycling center.

Water

Water Conservation

We are considered a zero discharge facility in Harford County because our plating process conserves water use while also eliminating water discharge. The plating process involves several wash downs or rinses. After using a fresh water rinse, the water is collected in a tank and heated for the hot water rinse. During the heating process, there is a reduction of volume due to evaporation and then after the hot rinse down, the water is reused for other rinses. Overall, reusing rinse water saves an average of 7-10 gallons of water daily or approximately 2,210 gallons annually.

Stormwater Management and Site Design

In the back of our building we have gravel, instead of pavement, and silt netting.
