We recycled 85-90% of all of our waste including cardboard, paper products, plastic and aluminum containers, printer cartridges, batteries, etc. We also recycle our surplus wooden pallets. Another company in our area uses any extra that we have so none of them end up in landfills. We have recently opened a branch warehouse in Dover Delaware and are continuing with our recycling practices there also.

Energy Efficiency

We have saved 10-20% on our electric bill by installing energy efficient lighting, motion sensing switches on all our lighting and huge ceiling fans in our warehouse for more efficient heating and cooling. We have also installed energy saving 3M window film on our office windows. To date, we have changed all of our outside lighting to LED and are continuing to change over all inside lighting as needed and are always looking for greener more efficient ways of doing business.
