The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) has reviewed the revised submittals constituting the "Construction Air Monitoring Plan" (CAMP), "Construction Sampling & Analysis Plan" (CSAP); and the "Standard Operating Procedure for Response Actions and Notifications to Action Level Exceedances" (SOPRAN) with attachments for the Area 1, Phase 1 Development, Baltimore Works Site, Baltimore, Maryland, also known as the Exelon Tower, Trading Floor/Garage and Central Plaza Garage project ("Exelon project"), dated March 2014, as received on March 25, 26, and 27, 2014. Based on this review, the referenced plans are approved and attached to the Detailed Design Plans in accordance with Section IV.19 of the 2003 Covenant Not to Sue governing the redevelopment of the subject site.

Based on consultation with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and after review of the Pre-Construction Air Monitoring Program data, MDE will determine the particulate action level. This level would be used during construction to trigger dust suppression activities, including work stoppage as described in the SOPRAN.
