- NRSB certification is formal recognition of professional excellence based on qualifications, high ethical standards, and continuing education in radon services.
- Encourage the public to use certified professionals
- We ensure our certified professionals are educated on correct practices
- NRSB is independently run by volunteer board members

The NRSB provides recognizable conformance to quality and confidence in the radon industry.



EPA-State only meeting on June 27, 2018


The meeting is being held at no cost and is intended to bring together interested parties concerned with protecting the public from unnecessary exposure of radon in homes, schools, public and private buildings.
