

Scheduling an Inspection

Adding a New Property Record



Lead Rental Certification and Accreditation





The Lead Rental Certification and Accreditation (LRCA) database requires an Accredited Inspector to schedule upcoming inspections.

When scheduled accurately and timely this procedure satisfies the requirement (COMAR 26.16.05.04) to provide notice to the department before performing an inspection.





Property records presented within LRCA have various sources - e.g. SDAT, LRCA, OLRR, Inspection Certification

OLRR

- SDAT
- Owner Lead Rental Registration
- Record presents data collected at the time of owner registration or updated during renewal.
- Record presents accurate information regarding historical ownership.
- New or updated OLLR records present in LRCA within 24 Hours

- Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation
- Record presents data obtained from SDAT Real Property Search
- Account Identifiers presented in LRCA (Property Number)
- SDAT record updates may be delayed based upon local jurisdictions



Property Record Sources



Inspection Certification

- Record source captured from a legacy handwritten inspection certification (Form 330)
- Record source details may be inaccurately presented
- Record source intended to be selected when scheduling a re-inspection of a legacy limited lead free inspection certification

LRCA

- Created by users on the LRCA database
- Provides solution for creating a new property record and present the current owner name and add dwelling unit identifier.
- *Note SDAT account number for property records created by users on LRCA should accurately reflect the subject property





During the "Schedule Inspection" procedure on LRCA an Inspector can create a new record for an existing property using a valid MDE Tracking ID.

Adding a new record of an existing property provides a solution for documenting the current owner name and a dwelling unit identifier.

Step 2 - Identify Property Record by SDAT Account

- Example -Use validated SDAT Account Number & MDE Tracking ID provided from the Property Owner
 - Property Account Number \rightarrow 0321040731001A
