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INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONFIRMATION OF SUITABILITY – END USER/INTERIM RECEIVING SITE FORM	
Part A – End User/Interim Receiving Site	
Name of End User/Interim Receiving Site	Insert the name of the End User/Interim Receiving Site that is receiving the fill material. A Receiving Site can include a facility where fill material is accumulated on an interim basis. Interim basis means the facility is processing or temporarily staging the fill material for less than three (3) calendar years prior to its use. The End User is the site where the fill material is utilized as backfill or other cover material.
Tracking Number	The Maryland Department of the Environment’s (MDE) Land Restoration Program (LRP) will assign a tracking number to the entity supplying the fill material when the sampling data is submitted for review.
Address	Insert the mailing address of the facility that is receiving the fill material on an interim basis or as an end user.
City	Insert the city in which the organization’s mailing address is located.
State	Insert the state in which the organization’s mailing address is located.
Owned By	Insert the name of the organization that owns the facility that has received the fill material.
Operated By	Insert the name of the organization that operates the facility that has received the fill material.
Contact Name	Provide the name of the contact person for the organization that is receiving the fill material on an interim basis or as an end user.
Email	Provide the email address of the contact person for the organization that is receiving the fill material on an interim basis or as an end user.
Phone Number	Provide the primary phone number of the contact person for the organization that is receiving the fill material on an interim basis or as an end user.
Categories	Please select the most appropriate category for the fill material received and identify the volume of material. Category 1- residential, unrestricted use Category 2- non-residential, restricted use Category 3- non-residential, restricted use, cap required Category 4- unacceptable for reuse <u>When selecting the category, this should be based on when the material is received and not after the material is processed for some future use.</u>
Groundwater Use Area	Please indicate if groundwater is used as a potable drinking water source at the site or an immediately adjacent property.
Quantity of Fill Material	Please indicate the quantity of fill material, in cubic yards, to be reused by the end user or accumulated by the Interim Receiving Site.
Part B – Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) Approval (for MDE use only)	
In this section, MDE shall review data for the fill material and identify the quantity of fill material eligible for a particular land use classification. MDE will insure the receiving site meets the appropriate land use classification category. For example, if a supplier has 500 cubic yards of fill material, the MDE shall review the data for the fill material. If all 500 cubic yards qualify for Category 1, the MDE will check the appropriate box and indicate that 500 cubic yards are eligible for this category.
