Dear Concerned Citizen:

The purpose of this letter is to update you on the air quality Permit to Construct application submitted by Tolson & Associates, LLC for one (1) crushing and screening operation, rated at 200 tons per hour, with five (5) engines located in your jurisdiction. A public hearing was held on May 22, 2019 to receive public comments on the application.

After review of all comments, the Department is satisfied that there will be no adverse impact to public health or the environment and has made a final determination to issue the permit. The Department will publish the enclosed notice at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in a daily or weekly newspaper of general circulation in the geographical area in which the proposed installation will be located. A final determination by the Department may be subject to judicial review as specified in the enclosed notice.

I have enclosed a copy of the Department's Response to Comments, mentioned in the notice, for your review. A copy has also been placed at the Crofton Community Library, located at 1681 Riedel Road, Crofton, MD 21114 for the public to review.
