e. A summary of proposed House Bill 167 was provided by Ellen Cohill. House Bill 167 would allow all units of State government to send electronically certain notices or communication to the public and receive same from the public If passed, this bill would take effect October 1, 2018. Discussion about the proposed bill focused on the need to include electronic payment with electronic acceptance of license renewal forms to allow staff to accurately track payments.

Industry Correspondence/State of the Industry

Brian Smith discussed his desire to build a relationship between this Board and the Board of the Maryland – Delaware Water Well Association ("MDWWA"). Mr. Smith provided an update on the scan in/scan out process, which will be in place for next year's convention. This year, there will be sign in/sign out sheets for each class. Mr. Smith stated that the MDWWA wants additional educational opportunities to develop career opportunities for young people. In addition, Mr. Smith indicated that there is a lack of communication between the two boards, specifically regarding licensing requirements and disciplinary actions.

BOARD VOTE TO MOVE INTO CLOSED SESSION

CLOSED SESSION: Pursuant to General Provisions Article ("GP"), § 3-305(b), on motion by Heather Quinn, seconded by Robert Peoples, the board members unanimously voted to move into a closed session on January 28, 2018 at 11:05 a.m., in the Aqua Room, for the purpose of complying with certain provisions of the Open Meetings Act.

Specifically, pursuant to GP § 3-305(b)(11) and (13) to discuss Apprentice Well Driller examination questions, which GP § 4-345 also prevents public disclosure of licensing examination questions. The Board made recommended changes to the Apprentice Well Driller examination. In a motion made by Brad Hartman, seconded by Heather Quinn, the board

members voted unanimously to make the recommended changes to the Apprentice Well Driller examination questions.

Also, pursuant to GP §§ 3-305(b)(7) and (13), for the purpose of consulting with counsel to obtain advice on Board appointment/reappointment process, thereby preserving attorney-client privilege under GP § 4-301(1). The Board unanimously accepted counsel's advice on Board appointment/reappointment process.

Pursuant to GP §§ 3-305(b)(2) and (8), for the purpose of consultation on complaint/potential litigation about a licensed person who is involved in a pending circuit court case, which GP § 4-333 also prevents public disclosure. The Board unanimously requested more information.

A motion to conclude the closed session was made by Brad Hartman, seconded by Robert Peoples. All were in favor. Motion carried. The closed session was concluded at 11:57 a.m.
