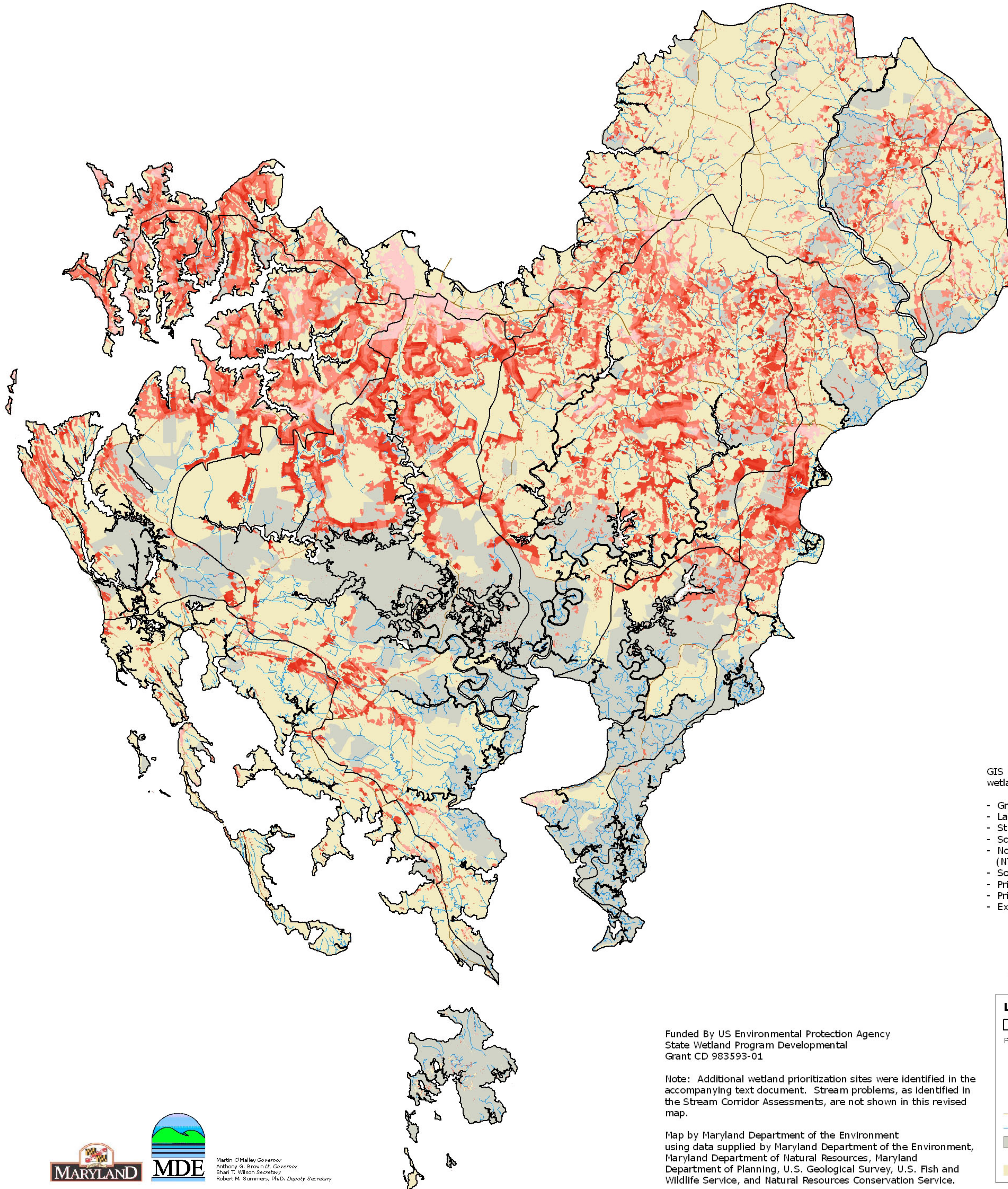
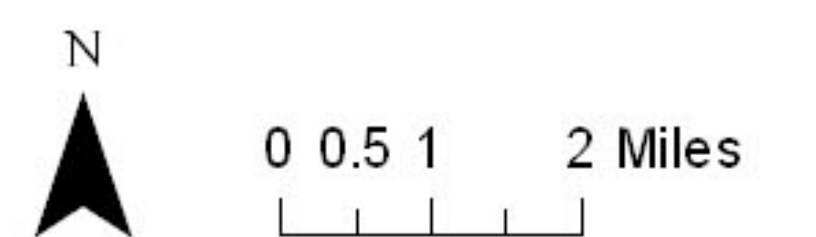


# Priority Sites for Wetland Restoration for Diversity in Dorchester County

- Streams and 100m buffer
- Scenic Rivers
- Nontidal Wetlands of Special State Concern (NTWSSC) and potential NTWSSC
- Soils w/drainage of SPD, PD, VPD
- Prime farmland
- Priority Funding Areas
- Existing Wetlands (DNR, NWI)
